However it works when you create tables. Here is my schema upgrading code:

```
All_Tables(sch);
if (sch.ScriptChanged(SqlSchema::SCHEMA))
    Sqlite3PerformScript(sch.Schema());
if (sch.ScriptChanged(SqlSchema::UPGRADE))
    Sqlite3PerformScript(sch.Upgrade());
if (sch.ScriptChanged(SqlSchema::ATTRIBUTES))
    Sqlite3PerformScript(sch.Attributes());
if (sch.ScriptChanged(SqlSchema::CONFIG)) {
    Sqlite3PerformScript(sch.ConfigDrop());
    Sqlite3PerformScript(sch.Config());
}
```

Unless you add a primary key on two columns in an existing table it works ok.
