Saving image to database:

```
//Database.sch
TABLE_ (TABLE_NAME)
SERIAL_ (SOME_ID) PRIMARY_KEY
BLOB_ (COLUMN_NAME)
END_TABLE

//code
Image img;

JPGEncoder jpg(90);
try{
    SQL & SqlInsert(TABLE_NAME)
        (COLUMN_NAME, SqlBinary(jpg.SaveString(img)))
}catch...
```

Loading it back:

```
try{
    SQL & SqlSelect(COLUMN_NAME).From(TABLE_NAME).Where(.....).Limit(1);
    if (SQL.Fetch()){
        Image img = StreamRaster::LoadStringAny(SQL[COLUMN_NAME]);
        //Use StaticImage to show your image on a screen
    }
}catch....
```
