My Exclamation() (Upp 5485) seems to be having a problem with some but not all '-' characters in its string argument. For example:

int I=-1;
String msg;
msg.Cat() << "I=" << I << " is negative (-)";
Exclamation(msg);
displays as: I=-1 is negative(-)
(as I would expect), but
int I=-1;
String msg;
msg.Cat() << "I-" << I << " is negative (-)";
Exclamation(msg);
displays as: I
         ERROR: Not in table: 1 is negative(-)
and
Exclamation("i -- is a negative number.");
displays as: I
         ERROR: Not in table: is a negative numbe
Any ideas as to how I could get Exclamation() to work more reliably would be appreciated.
