My Exclamation() (Upp 5485) seems to be having a problem with some but not all '-' characters in its string argument. For example:

```
int l=-1;
String msg;
msg.Cat() << "l=" << l << " is negative (-)";
Exclamation(msg);
```

displays as: l=-1 is negative(-)

(as I would expect), but

```
int l=-1;
String msg;
msg.Cat() << "l-" << l << " is negative (-)";
Exclamation(msg);
```

displays as: l  
ERROR: Not in table: 1 is negative(-)

and

```
Exclamation("i -- is a negative number.");
```

displays as: l  
ERROR: Not in table: is a negative numbe

Any ideas as to how I could get Exclamation() to work more reliably would be appreciated.
