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HI-

I may have narrowed it down a little more. It has to do with some automated testing. Apparently, you can feed a 'script' with a bunch of automated testing to a super statement executing thing that is deprecated and it runs the statements in the script and reports back if it was canceled or if errors. I don't really need it I don't think, but it is for automated testing of this fancy code. `CONSOLE_APP_MAIN` in firebird test demonstrates this script being run, and there are other tests that are run that don't use this automated script test. The new method to do this is overloaded about 4 times. It will require some refactoring to strip out the deprecated code and put the new script executor calling code in `console_app_main`. I don't think they will need that crazy typedef anymore.

I hope I helped someone find what is going on in the code. They probably could do that very fast and make the changes without me trying to figure it out anyway.

I am going to get in trouble if I don't get to bed. Work will be angry. I have to help run a busy clinic tomorrow!

I hope I figured that one out okay.
