The modules concept are easy. Modules will drop support for current double file system (header and implementation) and unify it in one file like it is in other languages like Java or other modern languages like go lang.

The code will look like this (Upp examplele)

// Core.cpp:

```
module Upp.Core;
```

```
class File
{
public:
    // File methods...
};
```

// MyProject.cpp

```
import Upp.Core; // No include, however #include "" will be probably still possible for backwards
compatibility.
```

```
CONSOLE_APP_MAIN // Macro handling is big mystery for me?
{
    File file;
    // Do something with the file...
}
```

The above example is only concept and it base only on my feature imagination. Of course the final implementation can be different, so you could study standard documentation to obtain more knowledge.
