for (int i = 0; i < Examples().GetCount(); ++i) {  
    if (Examples()[i].name == "User equation") {  
        TabUserEquation &tab = dynamic_cast<TabUserEquation*>(*Examples()[i].ctrl());  
        EditString &equation = tab.equation;  
        equation.SetText("HELLO WORLD!");  
    }  
}
```
