Slaving code:

tab_settings.Add(t_("Language"))
.Slave(&Ing_language)
.Slave(&txt_lang_check)
.Slave(&b_preview)
.Slave(&txt_preview);

If I don't slave the widgets they are still visible on top of the tab but you can't change tabs then so it is a problem.

I tested tabbing already when I started working with U++ a few weeks ago and it worked fine but now it doesn't and I can't remember what I did different. Any ideas?
