thank you for your suggestion. Indeed, your solution is the simplest, cross-compiling is too much effort for a newbie. I have successfully compiled and installed theide and also compiled some of the example applications that come with theide. Now I am compiling my own application developed using theide on windows. Compiling times are quite long, the first time (when you have to compile all the packages), once core packages are compiled compiling time is acceptable. For the sake of other people who may read this in future, to successfully compile theide on a fresh installation of noobs/raspbian are needed the devel package of gtk, x11, bzlib2.
