Hello,

First of all you need to check - how is "Event code 330 (BTN_TOUCH)" interpreted in GTK backend. It could be lost in transition or converted to click. The "eventtest" command is not helpfull for us it only means that the touch event works on your device. Please check CtrlCore/GtkEvent.cpp and log events:

```
gboolean Ctrl::GtkEvent(GtkWidget *widget, GdkEvent *event, gpointer user_data)
```

You could also try to understand the logic of the whole file.

Debugging and understanding U++ should not be hard to experienced developer. I started to fix some minor problems when I was after second year of computer science ;)
