Hello all

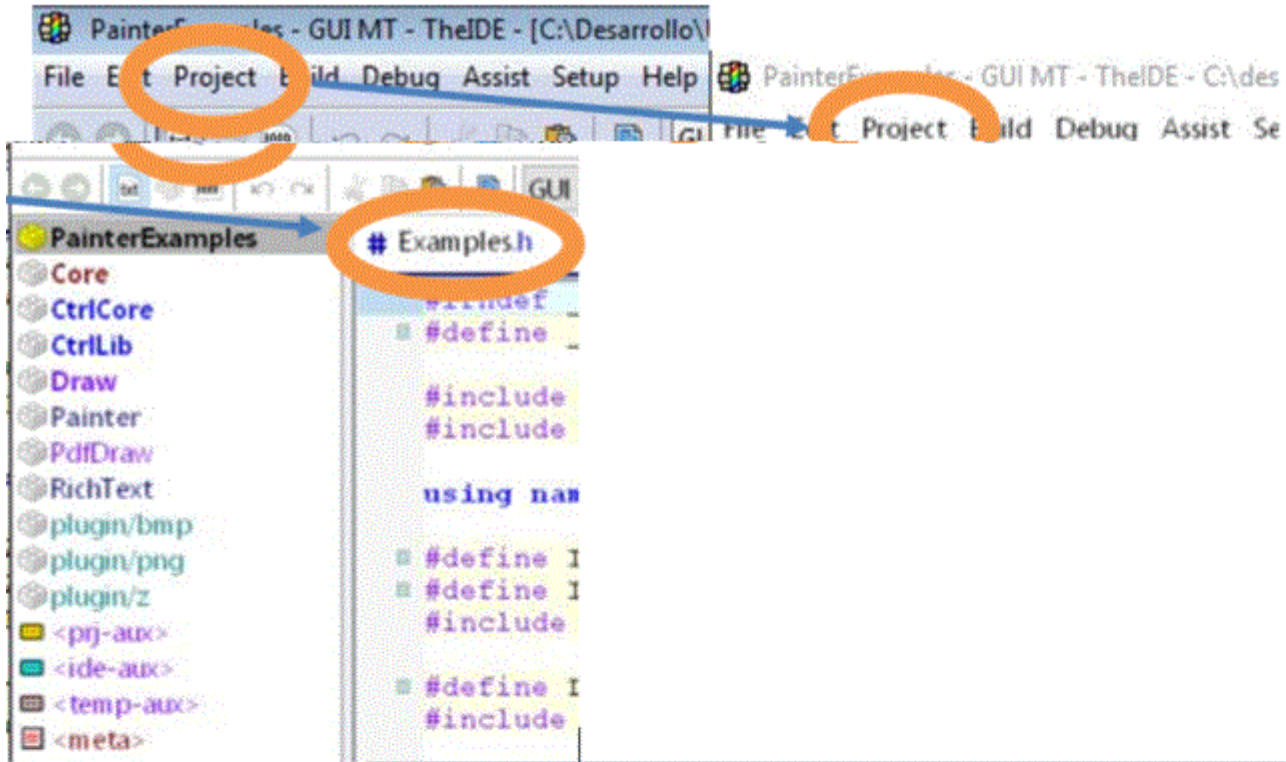
I think that the U++ applications seem blurred in Windows 10.
