Well, I have to admit that I am surprised that more of your controls, text, etc. do not flicker more than they do. But, basic stuff in that example flickers, so I'm guessing that in most complicated/phat apps, double buffering will be preferred. How do I easily turn on double buffering for the complete app at once? Is it a big performance killer in U++?

Just put BackPaint() in your app constructor. There can be some slowdown but it is only visible if your hardware is old.

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
