Hello Mirek,

Why not to keep request\_headers as Vector:

```
Vector<String> request_headers;
```

```
request_headers = {  
    "Accept: text/html,application/xhtml+xml,application/xml;q=0.9,*/*;q=0.8",  
    "Accept-Language: cs,en-US;q=0.7,en;q=0.3",  
    ...  
};
```

// The user can add custom headers to the vector with more straight forward way. Moreover user will not be obligated to remember about /r/n.

```
auto header = web_socket.StandardHeaders();  
header.Add("Custom-header: data");
```

// Deletion is also trivial of any of the standard headers.

```
request_headers.Remove(1); // Remove ""Accept:  
text/html,application/xhtml+xml,application/xml;q=0.9,*/*;q=0.8"", I don't need it!
```

// The set method also needs to be change

```
web_socket.RequestHeaders(request_headers);
```

\r\n can be added to the lines while processing. These approach is more flexible than String implementatino. Please let me know what do you think?
