This is a problem for PostgreSQL backend for sure.

TABLE(T)

```
...
DUAL_UNIQUE(A, B)
DUAL_UNIQUE(C, D)
END_TABLE
```

will generate A_script.sql containing:

```
...
alter table T add constraint DQ_T unique (A, B);
alter table T add constraint DQ_T unique (C, D);
```

Constraint names should be unique. The way to fix it is to add column names to the constraint name separated by some special symbol.
