No, this is not needed, if you added Apps (or with a different name) to first path of "Packages nest" for your assembly, where Rajce package available.

Sender Ghost wrote on Tue, 05 June 2018 20:207. Fix "Package nests" in some assembly, where Rajce package available:

path/to/Apps;path/to/ultimatepp/uppsrc

where path/to - is path to cloned rajce repository.

But looks like, you did this because of how current version of upp-cmake script(s) works.

Probably, there is a need to add Apps (or with a different name) to include directories of generated CMakeLists.txt file:

```
# Set the default include directory for the whole project
```

```
include_directories ( BEFORE Apps )
```

In other words, there is may be a need to add ability to specify path(s) for nest(s), which may be used as include directories for compiler also.
