In your home directory there should be .upp directory (this is also the place when TheIDE configuration is stored). You can look at my home directory listing:

```
[klugier@klugier-X470-Pro ~]$ ls -la | grep .upp
drwxr-xr-x 21 klugier klugier  4096 08-19 00:46 .upp
drwxr-xr-x  7 klugier klugier  4096 09-08 14:52 upp
drwxr-xr-x 27 klugier klugier  4096 08-19 00:45 upp.out
```

Can you execute the same command in your home (~) directory? Alternatively, you could mess with the users and the directory is created somewhere else in the system for example roots home directory. Please check and let me know everything works as expected.
