    try {
        retval = SQL % Select(SqlSum(DRUMS))
        .From(MYTABLE)
        .Where( MYFIELD == AsString(c) );
    } catch(SqlExc) {
        retval = -1;
        ErrorOK(t_("Error: ") + SQL.GetLastError());
    }
    return retval;
}
```
