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Hello Giorgio,

AFAIK, if you need to set the connection timeout value, you need to do it when opening a session.
E.g.

```
my_postgre_session.Open("host=localhost dbname=test user=test password=test  
connection_timeout=1000");
```

OTOH, if you need to set a timeout for queries (statement, etc.) there is a `statement_timeout` parameter which can only be called after a successful `Open()`.

You should "SET" it manually.
E.g.

```
SET statement_timeout = 5000
```
