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Hello,

I have two schemas (S1 and S2) in one database (D1). I have to join one table from S1 with one table from S2. I am connected to the database with user who is granted as owner of S1 and as reader of S2. Something like that :

```
SELECT T1.Col1, T1.Col2, S2.T1.Col2, S2.T1.Col3
FROM T1
INNER JOIN S2.T1 ON S2.T1.Col1 = S1.T1.Col1
```

When i try to do that with SqlExp like this :

```
Select(Col1.Of(T1),Col2.Of(T1),Col2.Of(T2),Col3.Of(T2))
.From(T1)
.InnerJoin(S2.T1).As(T2).On(Col1.Of(T2) == Col1.Of(T1))
```

...i obtain an error message that explains S2 is not declared.

So is it possible? If it is, how?
