I notice that every time I create new project/package in UPP, some libraries will be compiled first. E.g when creating console apps, UPP will always compile these packages before compiling your actual code.

- ---- plugin/z (GUI MSC17 MSC WIN32) (8 / 10)
- ---- plugin/png (GUI MSC17 MSC WIN32) (9 / 10)

This is similar with creating Java projects using maven. Each time maven is invoked, first it will download required Java libs from repository.

Isn't this a time consuming process, because it has to be repeated over and over again? Pardon my ignorance. This is mostly curiousity, not a criticism:)
