The problem is this method:

```
bool OkCommit(SqlSession& session, const char *msg) {  
    if(ErrorRollback(session, msg))  
        return false;  
    session.Commit();  
    return true;  
}
```

In the case of unsuccessful commit, nothing happens. This way it is very hard to detect the problem, because the next execution generates an error.

So I changed the method to this:

```
bool OkCommit(SqlSession& session, const char *msg) {  
    if(ErrorRollback(session, msg))  
        return false;  
    do{  
        session.Commit();  
        if(!session.WasError())  
        {  
            session.ClearError();  
            return true;  
        }  
    }while(IDRETRY==SqlError(t_("Unable to commit changes to database."), session, true));  
    return false;  
}
```
