Yes, you are right. I changed it to this:

```
bool OkCommit(SqlSession& session, const char *msg) {  
    if(ErrorRollback(session, msg))  
        return false;  
    session.Commit();  
    if(session.WasError())  
        return false;  
    session.ClearError();  
    return true;  
}
```

Application abort would be too drastic, I think, because this is one of the connections only. Programmer can use return value of OkCommit().
