As for abort/not abort, for some time I am thinking about some form of option that would abort SQL app in this and other cases, well, basically, after any unsuccessful unrecovered (by rollback) DML command. Checking for return code after each command is tedious (I usually just call OkCommit at the end of processing and rarely check the result).
