Still looks kinda amateur compared to KDE5 dark breeze theme (default dark in KDE5), but then again, that thing took decade+ to end in its current state, so I don't expect anyone to catch up after few hours of work, for the amount of time you are working on this, it looks very very good. Thanks!

I'm between two worlds: half of my effort is fixing bugs and parametrizing the skin for a future custom skin (make the current U++ implementation look good, but in line with what exists today), half trying to implement a good skin (I like this one <https://midnightsketch.com/>)

I wouldn't use exactly those separator frames, but for now they need to work correctly with dark mode and they don't really, so for now it will look like this.

The left separator frame is still wrong I think.

Once everything is fully skinnable to my liking and I ran tests even with RNG colors, we can work on making a custom skin that doesn't care about Win10 and looks hopefully less amateurish.

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
