Quote:Right-click the watch/auto line with ptr value, "Memory at...":

R-click shows only "Insert / Edit / Delete"-options in Watches-tab,
no effect when I R-click in Auto/Locals-tabs

Is there some setting I need to change, add something somewhere, an option I need to tick?

PS: I see this "Memory at" is in Pdb.h which depends on PLATFORM_WIN32 (in Debuggers.h
line 115)

Is it not available for Linux?
