In addition, it is possible to join the menu functions in one. For example:

tab.WhenSet = [&] {
    PromptOK("Selected tab " + FormatInt(tab.Get()));

    if (tab.IsAt(a1)) {
        PromptOK("At a1");
        menu.Set(THISBACK1(MainMenu, 1));
    } else if (tab.IsAt(a2)) {
        PromptOK("At a2");
        menu.Set(THISBACK1(MainMenu, 2));
    }
};

void Blam::MainMenu(Bar& bar, int num) {
    bar.Sub(Format(t_("Cookie %d"), num), [=](Bar & bar, int num) {
