Let's do this Git -> SVN synchronization and rename mirror to simply ultimattepp. I think all sides will be happy. The git users will have the opportunity to easily collaborate in the projects. The contributors will have the opportunity to provide more advances fixes that can be easily verify on the code review level by repo administrators.
