That doesn't mean advantage, just because I am familiar with CppSQLite, and I used it before, in my opinion, CppSQLite has simple interface, support precompiled SQL operation, support "getTable", that is very important for query and update side by side. As I know, many SQLite C++ wrapper varied from CppSQLite, ex. wxSQLite. I guess, the plugin needs some more upper layer wrapper for making it more general, right?

Thank you for your reply, and I will look more into the plugin, using the plugin has a quite good advantage: easily port to other database, I was battling with this point.
