I couldn't figure out how to force umk to use assembly name as a folder name. I was always getting a different folder name.

There is a possibility to specify output directory/file for umk. Just need to use absolute path to available output directory or create it before umk usage.

For example:

```
% mkdir -p out/uppsrc
% ./umk uppsrc ide CLANG -brs +GUI ${PWD}/out/uppsrc/theide
<...>
% ./umk uppsrc ide CLANG -brs +GUI ${PWD}/out/uppsrc
<...>
% ls -l out/uppsrc
ide
theide
```

Thanks. I knew that it is possible to pass to umk an absolute path to an output directory.  
But it is much more convenient to pass an extra-option and get behavior identical to TheIDE.

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
