I believe it is "openssl-devel" in rpms.

- \* libopenssl-devel on OpenSuse
- \* libssl-dev on Debian and Ubuntu
- \* Nothing to install on FreeBSD (installed by default) but libcrypto.pc, libssl.pc and openssl.pc are missing
