Is there a way to use U++ TheIDE and cxxtest framework for unit testing?

Well, it is still C++, so it should work, right?

Alternatively, you could setup something similar to U++ testing infrastructure. Instead of putting tests into some headers as classes, you can put individual tests / test groups into packages (we have now about 157 of these, see <https://github.com/ultimatepp/ultimatepp/tree/master/autotest>). Testing then compiles and runs one after another. I like to a bit more as each test is individual process, so if it crashes or freezes, other tests are not affected....
