aquilarubra wrote on Tue, 15 September 2020 17:14: Today I updated the Aur with version 14429. As there was quite a big change (GTK3 vs GTK2), it didn't compile that easily.

I ended up modifying mkfile, which was originally downloaded from [uppbbox/lpbuild2/](#). So, it might be interesting to update that folder accordingly or add my mkfile too:

I'm not so versed in makefiles, so it may be done in better ways. One thing that I wonder is why I had to add all the libs in LDFLAGS... aren't they be supposed to be taken automatically by the linker?

Anyway, it works now and uses clang.
