You can produce windows 32-bit applications out of box (in Win64).

You just cannot run development environment on windows 32-bit. I believe that is sooo niche that it is not worth supporting... I do not see any reason why anybody would rather run 32-bit windows instead of 64 on development box.

BTW, chances that your CPU is not 64bit capable are virtually nil and you can upgrade to Win10 64bit for free...
