Novo wrote on Mon, 12 October 2020 20:10I tried to build Upp in Alpine Linux (the one used by Docker) and got the following error (in Debug):
/home/buildbot/dvlp/cpp/code/upp/git/uppsrc/Core/Util.cpp:49: undefined reference to `backtrace'
/usr/bin/ld: /home/buildbot/dvlp/cpp/code/upp/git/uppsrc/Core/Util.cpp:50: undefined reference to `backtrace_symbols'

The problem can be fixed by adding of

```
DEBUG_LINK = "-lexecinfo";
```

to a build method.

But I believe this dependency should be detected automatically.

It would be great to fix that because that will make Upp easier to use with Docker.

Or we can just remove backtrace? I do not remember a single time it helped and this is continuous nuisance on all systems...
