Using Thread is fine! I was actually afraid that you are not using it, that would lead to leaks. You need to use Upp::Thread as it contains some allocator related stuff to release some allocation caches...

Anyway, from the very sparse info I am getting, I am starting to think that you might not be locking things properly when communicating between threads. I would guess that 'showDone' is something that you call from the thread to show progress in GUI. Do you lock things properly? E.g. with GuiLock ___?
