When i try to compress many files in one GZ file, only the last one is in it. Well, i think that GZ file is always open for writing only, not for writing and appending.

Now, it's looking like that :

IGz = "FicLog.gz";

if (ffFic.Search(IFic) && PromptYesNo("Delete log files?")){

        FileDelete(ffFic.GetPath());
    } while (ffFic.Next());
}
```
