Trying to build /uppsrc/ide under WindowsXP && MSC8 yields the error message

```
...\upp\uppsrc\ide\icondes\IconDes.h(5) : fatal error C1083: Cannot open include file:  
'IconDes/IconDes.h': No such file or directory
```

Indeed "IconDes.h" appears strange to me:

"#include <IconDes/IconDes.h>" lists a non-existing path which explains the error message. I think it should read: "#include <ide/IconDes/IconDes.h>".

Furthermore I cannot comprehend what sense it makes if a file (IconDes.h) includes itself (IconDes.h).
