Thanks for the info.

That's what I've suspected, and that's why I asked for you to check it against xterm.

The bash config. sets the ink color to white. (SGR 37). That color is meant to be changed by the user, If the background (which can be overridden by the theme) is the same color, then it'll be unreadable. (unless you explicitly set the color white or the paper color to something else on TerminalCtrl.)

I reproduced it with xterm, GNOME terminal, VTE and kitty. :)
We can call it a bash config/theme clash and a false alarm.
