Hi,

There are two relevant functions in GDK:

```
gdk_wayland_window_announce_ssd(GdkWindow *)  
gdk_wayland_window_announce_csd(GdkWindow *)
```

I think the former should be explicitly called on wayland when a window with any kind of decoration is created, unless we want csd, which seems to be the default settings for some reason.
