Hello Allen,

The assembly name you provide in your command line may be wrong :

```
./umk ./examples AddressBook CLANG -v ./adbook
```

The "./examples" should be just "examples".

In U++ "examples" is called an Assembly, there is plenty's assemblies in the default environnement (examples, uppsrc, MyAppS...) they are tied together by a configuration file that should be generated by default or if you launch TheIDE. By specifying examples as assembly, UMK will lookup for dependency required in other assembly (in your case it will find CtrlLib in uppsrc Assembly)
