The memory leak thing you encountered can be either take care of by your way of override Close() or by the suggested way of using smart pointer One. The latter is preferred.

Key is a virtual function, it can create an WhenKey event (just like I created the WhenSuspiciousKey event). If a WhenKey event is created, either by yourself or by the library you are using, you can assign a per-instance callback to tailor the particular object's behaviour. The virtual function Key is per-class. And it's not assignable. It's constant.
