Quote:2. Can the ctrl be used to run as a login shell? (not just as an emulator) (This is for applications that require use of .profile and not just .bashrc)

Yes you can. TerminalCtrl, being a ctrl, simply interprets a string input which may contain terminal escape commands and characters. You feed it with any source of string. It, however, comes with an optional/default PtyProcess class, which can runs system processes, including login shells. (If it doesn't suit your needs you can simply replace the pty with any other source)
