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Mirek,

It looks like a flag to avoid lookup of exe icons helps here. It needs just four lines of code added/changed in FileSel.

Add to class FileSel in FileSel.h:

```
bool load_exe_icons;  
FileSel& LoadExelcons(bool b = true)      { load_exe_icons = b; return *this; }
```

Add if condition to end of FileSel::SearchLoad() in FileSel.cpp:

```
if(load_exe_icons) lazyicons.Start(list, d, WhenIcon);
```

Reset flag default value added in FileSel::FileSel():

```
load_exe_icons=true;
```

For my use, I would nearly always use LoadExelcons(false); -- even as default -- as my default usage is to open documents, not exe files. However, setting load_exe_icons=true; by default, retains original default behavior.
