Ok, upon a closer look, it's really trivial.

The match for "printer" will obviously break in non-English locales:

```
Vector<String> l = Split(System("lpstat -p"), '\n');
for(int i = 0; i < l.GetCount(); i++) {
    Vector<String> w = Split(l[i], ' ');
    if(w[0] == "printer" && w.GetCount() > 1)
        printer.Add(w[1]);
}
```

Maybe lpstat -a is easier to parse. Although I'm not quite sure I understand the semantic differences from the -p option:

```
Vector<String> l = Split(System("lpstat -a"), '\n');
for(int i = 0; i < l.GetCount(); i++) {
    Vector<String> w = Split(l[i], ' ');
    printer.Add(w[0]);
}
```
