"make -f umkMakefile" - works.

Regular "make" (build TheIDE) didn't work (problem with linking).

Problem with CPU is fixed.

Autocomplete doesn't work for me. For example:

WStringBuffer txt;
```

txt.
```

Dot won't be autocompled. Ctrl+Space doesn't help either. I also tried autocomplete with TAB. To be fair, I never used autocomplete with TheIDE before, but I use it with VIM all the time.

That is weird. Looks like the whole thing is somewhat fragile in Linux

Are you testing latest llbm_ide branch, right? (make reference is confusing me a bit)
