While it is definitely a good idea, only one of these errors seems libclang related and fixable and it happens on theide exit. Anyway, now fixed.

That said, everything valgrind says is worth investigation. I was able to fix many of these issues (in master now), unfortunately it looks like majority of remaining problems is cairo related (these happen when we are reading images from gtk).

Any help identifying the cause(s) is welcome.
