Unfortunately, it seems to erroneously flag my structure packing pragma:

```
#pragma pack(push,1)
```

It complains about "Unterminated #pragma pack(push,...) at end of file". It seems to ignore:

```
#pragma pack(pop)
```

following the packed structure(s).

-Wno-pragma-pack seems to do the job. It is now default (but you will need to add it to Assist setup. Note that unless you update the ide (one more bug fixed), it needs restart).
