I understand that U++ currently aims to be compliant with c++14. Overall, U++ is very close to c++20 compliant.

IIRC, the only kind of complaints gcc/clang make when building TheIDE with std=c++20 is about capturing `this` by default is deprecated in c++20 for a lambda.

You can have one or another. It looks like

```
[=, this] {}; // until C++20: Error: this when = is the default
```

which supercomplicates the stuff everywhere unfortunately. So this change will have to wait a couple of years it seems.
