I found the problem. It is env/LC\_CTYPE variable.

My locale is set to tr\_TR.UTF-8

For now, clangd doesn't seem to like it.

Changing LC\_CTYPE to en\_US did the trick for me, on all ArchLinux installations...

I am not entirely familiar with clangd's behaviour (yet) but if it requires LC\_CTYPE to be ASCII en\_xx values, maybe TheIDE should ensure that it is.
