Hello,

I have seen many methods like `IsEncrypted()`, `ChangePassword()`, `Open(..., cypher)`... so it seems that the db can be encrypted. I need not to let the user to open the db with some external tool like DB for Sqlite Browser and performs unwanted operations.

I would like to have a very short example of:

1. how to create a db in some encrypted way;
2. how to read/write data while it is being used by my U++ client (if the queries need some special flag).

From what I read so far it seems that should be enough to open the database in this way:

```
if(!sqliteVT.Open( dbname, some_password,  
Upp::Sqlite3Session::CIPHER_CHAHA2020_DEFAULT )) {  
...  
}
```

all the rest remain the same. Can you confirm?
